FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS CAR BOOT MARKET

What is a Car Boot Market?

The Car Boot Market provides a platform for individuals to sell items they no longer need, usually from the boots of their cars or small stalls. Sellers offer goods that are often unwanted or no longer required, creating a diverse array of offerings that can change each month depending on the rotating stalls.

When and where does the Car Boot Market take place?

The Car Boot Market takes place every first Sunday of the month, coinciding with the City Centre Sunday Market, and is hosted in the Castle Street Carpark.

What can be sold at the Car Boot Market?

The merchandise typically ranges from clothing (including vintage and retro pieces) to homewares, jewellery, and other pre-loved items.

How can I book a stall at the Car Boot Market?

To secure your space at the Car Boot Market, all you need to do is complete the online form.

What are the opening and closing times of the Car Boot Market?

The Car Boot Market is open to customers from 8am – 1:30pm

What are the bump in instructions for the Car Boot Market?

Bump in will be from 6am, please do not come before this time as we need to regulate the traffic flow within the market of the existing stallholders so you will not be able to enter the carpark before 6am.

Please queue up at the Castle Street entrance to the carpark, there will be someone there to mark you off and to direct you from there where to go.

When entering the carpark, please ensure that you drive extremely slowly and pop on your hazard lights.

Under no circumstances are there to be vehicles moving within the car park after 7am so please ensure you are not running late.

How much does it cost to be a stallholder at the Car Boot Market?

Stall fees are \$25 for a single site (1 x standard car space with approximately 2metres in front of car) or \$40 for a double site (2 x standard car space with approximately 2metres in front of car). Payment will be taken sometime throughout the day from your stall via EFTPOS, if this is an issue and you require to pay cash, this can be arranged, but must be paid in advance at the concierge desk in Coffs Central.

Is the market cancelled in the case of bad weather?

The Car Boot Market is undercover and ALL-WEATHER – In fact some of our busiest days are the rainy ones at the market, so no need to cancel in the event of a rainy day.
